The MBA Curriculum of most universities or business school require students to submit a Research-based Dissertation in which the student has to demonstrate at an advanced level an ability to apply important intellectual and practical skills derived from theory studies during the Formative Module Phase. These skills are valued by employers and the student is expected to provide proof that he/she has mastered a clear understanding of the theoretical subject matter and is able to apply it in a practical environment. Students will also be expected to demonstrate organisational and time-management skills covered during the undergraduate stage of the BBA/MBA Curriculum. Furthermore, the student will be required to hone research skills and techniques and illustrate an in-depth understanding of at least one major area of business and/or business-related area. Other high-level skills which will be required include evaluation, synthesis, and critical thinking, and finally, communication and presentation skills. In addition to the Researched-based Dissertation the student will be required to complete a few selected theoretical modules relevant to the specific academic outcomes of the specific university or business school. These modules will entail a Formative as well as Summative Moderated Assessment component.

UK UNIVERSITY PROGRESSION

The MBA Top-Up Phase (60 Credits) converts the Post-Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDip.Man) (120 Credits) to a full MBA Degree (180 Credits). Upon completion the student is awarded a MBA Degree by a UK University of choice.

UK-OFQUAL & UK-BAC CERTIFIED

The PGDip.Man and MBA Top-Up combines to form a full Master's in Business Administration (MBA) Degree and is awarded by the UK–BAC university selected to complete the Capita Selecta and MBA Dissertation.

MODULAR ACADEMIC SYSTEM

The Master's in Business Management (MBA Top-Up) (RQF-Level 7') can be completed in 3 to 6 months. This enables the student to complete a combined BBA/MBA Curriculum (MBA Degree) within 30 months of departing from high school.

DUAL QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

EDUVISA provides the student with both UniQual (IQF) curriculum content certification as well as Ofqual (RQF) qualification accreditation relevant to our accelerated Integrated Bachelor (BBA) and Master's (MBA) Degree Programme.





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
